VP Sport | as part of his manifesto had encouraged Sports Executives to have a Welfare Officer on the committee and with Amy M had held a Teams Group meeting with a view to a 'bouncing of ideas' and sharing the experiences of those clubs that had done this in the past | Winter Virtual Roses underway | continuing with Corona activities | had attended a very useful Student Experience Committee meeting | had met with a company providing a careers platform for student athletes.

SU President | attended University Council where it declared a climate emergency and ? definition of anti-semitism [good news] | attendance at various high level University meetings | made the committee aware that the University Management Advisory Group [UMAG] had been abolished. However, Oliver

would have less oversight of the University's plans/activities, as he could not be on the replacement bodies as the expectation was collective responsibility for individuals on that body and he could not be bound by collective responsibility in University institutions.

VP Media & Activities | Societies Forum and new Federation Chairs in place and upcoming meeting | working on Veganuary campaign for January | attended ReFreshers Fair meeting and Student Experience Committee | had a helpful meeting with the Interim Chief Executive to streamline manifesto ideas and priorities | communications out to determine what society activities were taking place | helping to promote the Sportswoman app.

LGBTQ+ Officer | voting underway | memorial up in Library for Transgender Remembrance and good feedback coming through, hoped to continue the good relationship both with LGBTQ+ staff network and the Library going forward | took part in the Transgender Remembrance vigil | Forum general meeting passed the bylaw changes and elected new Executive Committee for 2021 although no-one ran for the role of BAME Officer [nominations to be re-opened for by-election].

Mature Students' Officer | general meeting held and now have full officer team for the first time | excellent cook-along led by Goh Yu Hong, and although turnout was small those who attended enjoyed it [hope was for another event] | looking ahead at a discussion/event on the future of higher education and joint event with the LGBTQ+ forum History month | the fact it was hard to build engagement remained | to work on the development of the feedback questionnaire on the whole transition into postgraduate studies / study for mature undergraduates | end of term online event planned in the form of a talent show but volunteers and commitment were required for it to go ahead.

International Students' Officer | forum to review past welfare events as turnout smaller than hoped

Womens+ Officer | work to move elections to January and conversations taking place re doing these [as democratically as possible] by panel and merits as opposed to election | looking to add BAME Ambassadors to the Executive with a view to increasing representation | working on term 2 events/campaigns, to include Reproductive Rights on Abortion and Miscarriage, and looking to get non-binary members involved | from the International Day of Elimination of Violence against Women, working towards 16 days of activism until Womens' Rights Day.

BAME Students' Officer | been involved in discussions re safety of being an ethnic minority to increase levels of awareness or support | about to share out new reporting services being set up using confidential email | finally completed the extensive short to long term policy | various meetings held with NUS Liberation team to discuss the De-Colonisation campaign | worked with the VP Media & Societies to get the Societies Federation up and running | worked with the VP Union Development to arrange a BAME stakeholders meeting and preparing a presentation for Westminster politicians and industry experts on how to improve equality, diversity, inclusion on campus for BAME and ethnic students.
