#### Pushing for more proactive and accessible mental health services

• Rates of violence and sexual offences in Lancaster are over 2% higher than the national average, and I will push the university to offer more protection and support for students living or going out in town.

#### Increasing provisions of free menstrual products across campus

 Menstruators aged 18-24 are the most likely demographic to be impacted by period poverty. Lancaster University only advertises free period products in 5 locations across campus, many of which are not restocked regularly, leaving over 50% of Lancaster students unsupported.

#### **Encouraging student-lead initiatives**

• The student body should feel able to raise issues that matter to them to the Union and receive appropriate guidance and regular support to help them have a voice in their university experience.
