Training & Development: Comprehensive training and induction for Liberation & Campaigns Officers. Attendance at national events and conferences. Continuous on-going training and development, relevant to the needs of the individual and their aims.
Duties of the International Students' Officer: The roles and duties of the International Students' Officer are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To coordinate and support the activities of the International Students' Forum;• Support and empower international student leaders across the organisation to deliver events and campaigns; and• Engage with international students and represent their concerns to the University and Students' Union.
Duties of all Liberation & Campaigns Officers: All Liberation & Campaigns Officers are expected to undertake the following duties: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Attend and engage with Union Assembly;• Uphold and take responsibility for their own adherence to the relevant Forum Terms of Reference, Articles, Bye Laws, regulations and policies to ensure the effective governance and development of the Union; and• Report safeguarding concerns and signpost students to Union, University, and external wellbeing services.
