



Lancaster University Students' Union Elections

Guidance on Endorsements

Any individual Lancaster University student can publicly endorse and/or campaign for a candidate in our elections.

However, there are some rules and exceptions that we have in-place to keep our elections fair and fun:

1. **Anyone who is not a student is not allowed to endorse or campaign for a candidate.** That includes: lecturers, Students' Union staff, staff at your favourite takeaway, your parents, etc.
2. **Anyone who is part of the Students' Union's Trustee Board cannot publicly endorse a candidate.** That means the current Full-Time Officers and Student Trustees have to remain impartial.
3. **Candidates are not allowed to form a "slate".** A slate is a group of candidates campaigning together. This means candidates can't endorse another candidate – for instance a candidate for the role of President couldn't also encourage students to vote for their friend who is a candidate for the role of Wellbeing Officer.
4. **Societies, sports teams, or any other group cannot endorse as a collective.** A candidate can be endorsed by the President of the Society, or even the entire executive, but cannot be endorsed by the society as a whole.
5. **Endorsements must be positive in their nature.** Endorsements should be a statement of why you are voting for a candidate, not an encouragement of opposition to another candidate.

As a student leader, you may be asked by a candidate to endorse them, their manifesto, and their campaign. We encourage you to do this – if you feel comfortable!

We want to use your endorsement wisely!

Maybe you want to speak to all the candidates first? Perhaps you'd like a commitment from them on something you care about before committing to an endorsement?

Remember: you are allowed to endorse as many or as few candidates as you like! You can withhold or withdraw your endorsements at will.
