Visits to Society, Club or Group Events

During the campaigning period (10am, Friday 27th Feb – 6pm, Thursday 5th March), candidates might want to come and speak to your society, club or group during a meeting, event, or activity.

Here's some important things to know before campaigning starts:

1. **You have control over candidates' access to your activities.** You might be happy for them to join any time, or you might want them to only come at a certain time. You might even want to ban them outright.
2. **You have control, but you must be fair.** If you are applying a rule to one candidate, then you need to apply it to their competitors too. You could decide to only allow candidates for certain positions to speak to you, but again you need to be consistent.
3. **If you feel a candidate oversteps, you should tell us!** Candidates are bound by the Election Rules to ensure our elections are fun and fair. Email us on lancastersuelections@lancaster.ac.uk.

Like with endorsements, we want you to be aware that you have power and control during the election period. Please use it wisely and **make sure all the members of your group take the time to cast their all-important votes.**
