Postgraduate & Mature Students' Officer

Molly O'Reilly-Kime Manifesto

Hello! My name is **Molly (they/them)**, I'm a first year CompSci PhD student and I'm running to be your **Postgrad & Mature Students' Officer for 23/24**. I arrived in Lancaster as a mature student in 2019, graduating last year and beginning postgrad study this January.

I want to establish a healthy student-lead community for Postgrad and Mature (PGM) students. The PGM Officer is the **only elected LUSU position representing this specific aspect of student life**, so it is essential that our voices are heard. As your PGM officer, I will introduce the following initiatives:

- Better treatment for Graduate teaching staff
- A family-friendly campus
- Re-establishing the PGM Forum
- College affiliation for Grad students

I am familiar with **the workings of LUSU and the Forums**, having been involved in student groups since my first week on campus: I've held numerous exec roles including President of the Real Ale and Cider Society and Social Sec for the LGBTQ+ Forum. With my experience, I am confident that I will be able to realise these goals.

Better Treatment for Graduate Teaching Staff

Graduate teaching staff are in a gray area when it comes to their status as **both students** and **staff**. This leads to unnecessary complications around the facilities that we have access to. I will:

- Push for graduate teaching staff to have access to staff bus passes, cycle-to-work schemes, and parking spaces.
- Push for a more cohesive approach to teaching contracts: they are currently issued termly regardless of circumstances, causing issues with access to the staff intranet.
- Ensure that **staff disciplinary procedures** are carried out appropriately and fairly.

A Family-Friendly Campus

There are a number of university and SU facilities that would make life easier for PGM students with **families and caring duties**. I will:

- Push for access for **childcare facilities** for students with young children.
- Work with student media groups and the library to provide family-friendly events including film screenings.
- Create more and diverse family-friendly spaces on campus, such as through increasing the availability of baby changing stations and nursing facilities across campus.

Reestablish the PGM Forum

There is huge variety in the experiences of PG and mature students – there is no one-size-fits-all solution for nurturing our community. The reestablishment of the PGM Forum is essential for improving the **quality of PGM experiences** at Lancaster. I will:

- Hold regular events both on and off campus, particularly towards the beginning of the year, to encourage involvement with the Forum and reestablish an exec committee.
- Ensure that the PGM Forum has active, engaging social media.
- Structure **exec elections** for the Forum in a way that will enable students who are on one-year courses, or began their studies later in the academic year, to **get involved**.
- Review the PGM Forum byelaws, which are in dire need of an update.
- Offer PGM-specific events during Welcome Week and ReFreshers, such as a PGM hour at Freshers Fair.

College Affiliation for Grad Students

Despite making up **25% of LU's student body**, graduate students are relegated to a single college - in contrast with the 8 undergrad colleges. This **puts pressure on Grad College** to cater to a huge group with a wide range of needs and interests, and diminishes the opportunity for PG students to **engage with college identity**.

I will introduce a **college affiliation program for PG students**, which will allow them to retain their Grad College membership while also having access to the social aspects of UG colleges, including **socials and college sports**.

- PG students progressing at LU can maintain ties with their UG college.
- Incoming PG students will be able to choose an affiliate college.
- College JCRs will be encouraged to have a **dedicated PGM officer** on their exec.
- Additionally, Grad college events will be opened up to mature students who may feel out of place at UG events.

There is a lot of work to be done to improve the **visibility**, **representation**, **and treatment** of

PGM students within LUSU. I hope that with my knowledge and experience of working within LUSU and student groups, I can help to build a **strong and vocal community of PGM students** within Lancaster University.
